



The 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting (E) of the Managing Committee was called in emergency on 15th October, 2020 at 8 PM in the Society Office. It was chaired by Shri Kamlesh Kumar Jha, Vice-president of the Society and the below honourable members were present in the Emergency MC Meeting.

An emergency meeting of the MC was held to discuss a letter from RCS office letter no: 47/95A/APH/SEC-III/RCS/2020/1180 dated 7th October, 2020 which was received on 12th October, 2020 seeking para-wise comments on complaints of five Janaki GHS members dated 28.09.2020.

MC noted that Smt Sheela Jha, Shri BK Singh and other three non-members have submitted complaints in RCS alleging the Managing Committee of the Society. RCS vide above-mentioned letter has forwarded



the same, seeking para-wise comments of the MC within 7 days.

In perusal of the said complaint, the MC members present in the meeting has examined each point and came to conclusion that the complaints are completely false and baseless with the intention to disrupt the functioning of the present MC. The MC further noted that three signatories of the complaint letter dated 28.09.2020 (flat 613, 707 and 413) were not members of the society.

(a) Flat No. 707 :- Shri Bhaskar is the member of Society of flat no 707 and has not signed the letter.

(b) Flat No. 413 :- Dr. Sanjay Kumar Mishra is the member of flat 413 whereas the letter is signed by N Jha, who is not a member.

(c) Flat No. 613 :- Ms. Tulka was not member of the society on 28/9/2020. She has been awarded the membership on 4th October, 2020.

So it implies that the complaint is made by Smt Sheela Jha, flat no 616 and Sh B K Singh, flat 512 are bonafide members of the Society.

It has been observed by the MC that there is a mischievous group who is trying to create a disturbance by hook & crook. MC recalled that a few weeks ago



impersonation of our bonafide members to use their name/identity fraudulently was reported. The reported instance was a theft under section 66-C&D of the IT Act, 2008. On preliminary investigation it was revealed that "IP Address spoofing" has been used to hide the sender's identity with help of VPN, etc with malafide intentions to malign the reputation of MC of the Society.

The MC has already decided to hold the election for post of President on 4th October, 2020. Therefore, MC prepared para-wise comments/reply on the complaint and directed Hon'ble Secretary to communicate to RCS with all relevant evidences.

MC further unanimously resolved that the issues raised in complaint are baseless and bogus with ulterior motive of harassing the present MC who are trying to do their best to manage the affairs of Society as per DCS Act & Rules.

Accordingly while replying to the letter, the RCS should be requested to dismiss/drop the complaint against the present Managing Committee.
